CHAPTER 2

Chapter 2: How to Create the Puppet Ministry

1. Forming the Team:

Recruitment:

- Hold informational meetings at the church to explain the purpose of the ministry.
- Recruit volunteers with a passion for children and a willingness to learn.

Key Roles:

- **Directors:** Oversee the ministry and organize rehearsals.
- **Puppeteers:** Manipulate puppets during plays.
- **Scriptwriters:** Write scripts based on biblical passages.
- **Technical Team:** Manage lighting, sound and effects.

Chapter 3: Materials and Puppet Creation

1. Materials Needed:

- **Wooden Sticks:** Manipulate arms and head.
- **Scissors and Cutter:** For precise cuts.

2. Puppet Construction:

Step 2: Cut the Pieces

- Cut out the body, arms, head and clothes using molds.

Step 3: Join the Parts

- Use hot glue or stitching for durability.

Step 4: Add Details

- Glue eyes, hair, clothes and accessories to customize.

1. Writing Works:

Central Message:

CHAPTER 5

Chapter 5: Small Example Plays

Work 1: “The Little Lost Sheep”.

Message: God always looks for us when we wander away.

Characters: Shepherd, Sheep, Friends.

Script:

Narrator: (In a warm voice) “In a quiet valley, a shepherd was lovingly caring for his sheep...”

Shepherd: “Dear sheep, stay close so that nothing bad happens to you.”

Little Sheep (walking away): “I’ll just take a little walk.... What fun it is to explore!”

Narrator: “The little sheep wandered off without realizing the danger she was in. The shepherd, noticing her absence, felt great concern.”

Shepherd: “Where is my little sheep, I must find her!”
(The shepherd searches for her tirelessly, facing obstacles such as rivers and mountains).

Shepherd (excitedly): “Here you are, little one! I thought I’d lost you.”

Song:

(Soft and cheerful melody) “I am the little sheep that got lost,

my Shepherd found me.

With love he carried me,

and now I’m better.”

Closing Verse:

“I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.” (John 10:11)

Play 2: “The Good Samaritan”.

Message: To love our neighbor.

Characters: Jesus (Narrator), Traveler, Good Samaritan, Thieves, Priest, Levite.

Script:

Jesus: “There was a man traveling along a lonely road...”

Thieves (threatening): “Give him all you have!” (they attack him and leave him wounded).

Narrator: “The traveler lay badly wounded on the ground, unable to get up.”

Priest (passing quickly): “I can't stop, I have important things to do.”

Levite: “I can't help, someone else will.”

Good Samaritan (with compassion): “Friend, I won't leave you alone! I will help you.” (takes care of him and takes him to a shelter).

Song:

(quiet melody) “I will help, I will love,

I will care for my neighbor.

With heartfelt love,

I will serve with devotion.”

Final Verse:

“Love your neighbor as yourself.” (Matthew 22:39)

Work 3: “The Mustard Seed”.

Message: Faith, though small, grows enormously.

Characters: Seed, Gardener, Narrator.

Script:

Narrator: “Jesus said that faith is like a mustard seed...”

Seed (shy voice): “I’m so small.... Can I really do something big?”

Gardener: “I’m going to plant you with love and patience. If you trust God, you will grow.”

(The gardener plants the seed and waters it carefully).

Seed (growing slowly): “I’m growing! God is doing something wonderful in me.”

Narrator: “The little seed grew into a big tree, offering shade and shelter to all.”

Song:

(Upbeat melody) “Little am I, but I’m going to grow,
my faith in God nothing can stop.

As a strong tree I will be,
if in his love I will always believe.”

Final Verse:

“If you have faith as a mustard seed...nothing will be impossible for you.” (Matthew 17:20)

Chapter 6: Worship and Spirituality

1. Moments of Worship:

Christian Songs:

- Use upbeat music with simple choreography.

Time for Reflection:

- Close each presentation with a short prayer.

2. Children's Devotionals:

Bible Stories:
